This report shows the various properties and formulas which can be used for formatting number values. Custom formatting is possible instead of using the system default format.

Rounding		
12,345.6800	12,345.6789	The blue number should be rounded to 4th decimal place

Reverse sign for display

Suppress if zero		
0.00		The blue number should be not visible as the number is zero and should be suppressed.
0.00		The blue number should be not visible as the property formula for "suppress if zero" returns true.
0.00	0.00	The blue number having the same value like the black one should be visible as the property formula for "suppress if zero" returns false.





Show zero values as		
0.00	_	There should be a blue minus (-) character visible.
0.00	0	There should be a blue zero (0) visible.





Use leading zero				
0.50	0.50	There should be a blue number with the same value like the black one as "use leading zero" is true.		
0.50	.50	There should be a blue number without the leading zero as "use leading zero" is false		
0.50	0.50	There should be a blue number with the same value like the black one as the property formula for "use leading zero" returns true.		
0.50	.50	There should be a blue number without the leading zero as the property formula for "use leading zero" returns false.
